The intended use includes, but is not restricted to, your European Sport Federation website, publications, European Sport Federation uniforms, pre Baku 2015 events etc.

Furthermore BEGOC hereby authorize your European Sport Federation to pass on the authority to use this logo to each of your European member Federations. Each European Sport Federation will be responsible for ensuring that any use of the Baku 2015 logo by its member Federations is in line with the restrictions contained in the attached guide.

BEGOC reserve the right to withdraw permission to your European Sport Federation and member Federations in the event that it believes that the use of the Baku 2015 logo is outside the issued guidelines and/or has, or could cause damage to, the Baku 2015 or European Games brands.
